

## **Instytut Reumatologii (REUMAPOL)**

Institute of Rheumatology is a main National Health Institution providing research, education and health promotion related to rheumatic conditions. Research area covers clinical investigations, basic research, epidemiology, health promotion, medical education, pharmacoeconomy, and psychology of health. Aims of scientific work are: I. "Pathogenesis of Rheumatic Diseases and Implementation of Results into Modern Diagnostic Process and Treatment" II. "Establishing Priorities for Diagnosing and Treatment to Constrain Disability Caused by Rheumatic Diseases". Population – based study on rheumatic complaints and diseases was provided in 2002 on a representative sample of 4 thousand persons. After medical verification in 2003 it is possible to describe occurrence of RA and SA in Poland, comparable to results in the EU. A project on costs of Rheumatic Arthritis in Poland, also on representative sample to realise in cooperation with GPs and specialists in rheumatology is ready to start.
